A group of European EA's together with the Euroteam, Fr Luke and Franklin from the World secretariat gathered in beautiful surroundings in Lithuania for a meeting of the European ecclesiastical assistants. We were delighted also to welcome Fr Zygmunt the EA of CLC Syria who joined us for two days of reflection on “Journeying with CLC-CVX”, primarily looking at the role of the EA but also taking time to reflect and share on other issues including leadership, group guide selection and training, formation in the Spiritual Exercises and other topics suggested by the participants. The initial sessions were led by Fr Luke and Alan Harrison the EA of England and Wales who shared their thoughts on the role of the EA within CLC/CVX, also with reference to the Church and the Society of Jesus (Progressio supplement 65) as well as looking at some areas of concern. This in turn stimulated sharing by the participants of their own experience of this role within their own National Community. We were extremely grateful for the excellent hospitality shown us by the CLC community in Lithuania who amongst other things arranged a visit to the City of Vilnius for the group and a social on the Saturday where we were delighted to have so many of the community join us for the celebration of the Eucharist with the Lithuanian Provincial. Our time together was a time of real joy, encouragement and many graces where we really experienced a deep sense of community.
